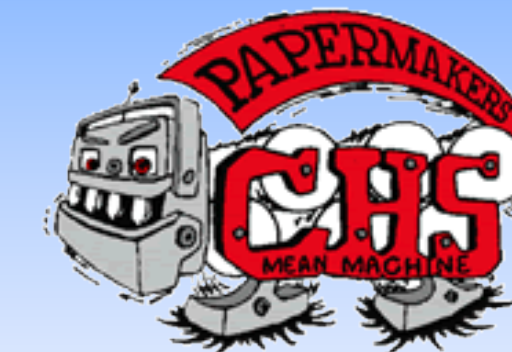

(justified)

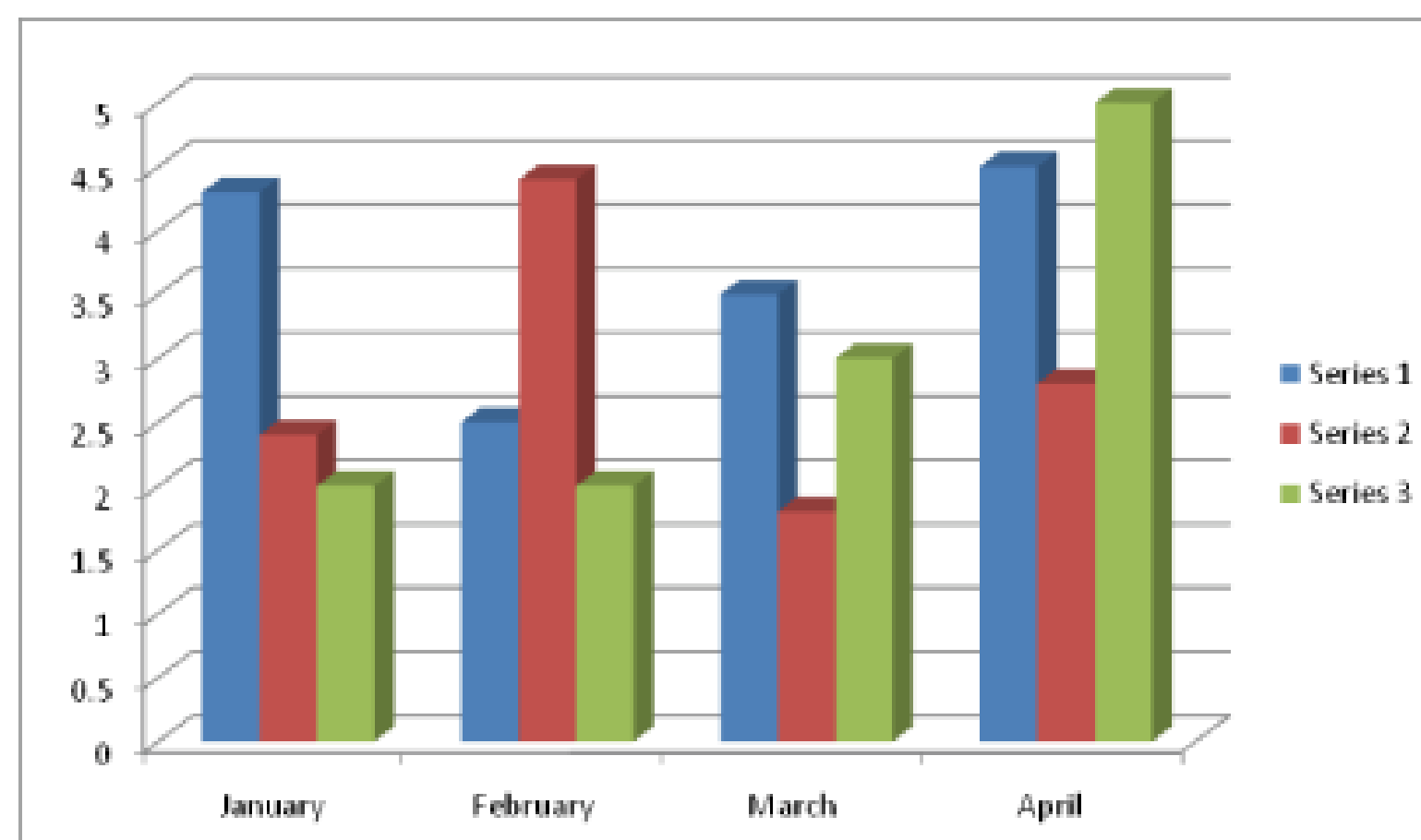


Figure 2: EVERY time you insert a picture or graph or data table, you must include a caption.
